Economic Status:	The Dominican economy depends on agriculture, primarily bananas, and remains highly vulnerable to climatic conditions and international economic developments. Tourism has increased as the government seeks to promote Dominica as an "ecotourism" destination.

US Presence:	The US does not have an embassy in Dominica; the US Ambassador to Barbados is accredited to Dominica.
